



2019 WRP GENERAL RULES

- All competitors must run the Spec tire for their respective classes, regardless of whether they are running for points or not.
- In the event of rain, we will make every effort to race. All classes must run Bridgestone Rain Tires. Kid Kart is open rain tires.
- 6" diameter wheels are NOT allowed.
- There is no wheel width rule.
- Fuel for all classes must be purchased at the track. There will be NO EXCEPTIONS for the 2019 season.
- Oil is open.
- Airboxes are MANDATORY in all Two Cycle and Shifter Classes.
- All Briggs/Clone Classes must run RLV Mufflers.
- No Axle Clutches w/ the exception of the Open Class.
- Bodywork is open, provided it is mounted safely and secured.
- Seats are open, provided they are mounted safely and secured.
- All karts must have numbers on all four corners.
- Factory Briggs Engine rules for all L0206 classes.
- Based on observation and testing, Left Hand drive Briggs engine karts will be permitted in competition.
- WRP will comply with Briggs & Stratton L0206 Club Program to allow racers to compete in that championship.
- Engine Tech, Chassis tech and General Rules (except those noted in these pages) for all classes will use the 2012 WKA Technical Manual.
- At the race directors discretion, the track may claim a competitors Briggs L0206 engine at any time. The track will supply the competitor with a new, factory sealed engine in direct exchange for the competitors **as raced** engine. If the competitor fails to comply with the claim requested, the competitor will be excluded for participating for 1 year and will forfeit all points acquired to date. The same will apply if a claimed engine is found to be blatantly illegal.
- Snell 2010 or Better Helmet, Jacket or Suit/Neckcollar/Gloves are Mandatory at all Times
- Ribvests are **MANDATORY** for all drivers under 13 years of age.
- All Lead Weights must be cotter keyed or double nutted and all brakes and steering bolts/nuts must be cotter keyed.
- Add 20 pounds to the minimum weight if you are running front brakes in any single speed class (does not include shifter class, no additional weight needed)
- WRP reserves the right to combine multiple classes of age and similar speed should kart / driver counts warrant it.
- WRP will consider adding other classes as needed should the kart / driver count warrant it.
- Disqualifications **cannot** be dropped, no shows/non-entries can be dropped.
- All MINORS must have MINOR RELEASE on file and signed by Parent/Legal Guardian before they can be allowed to practice or race. NO EXCEPTIONS. (Available at Track)
- Video Cameras are allowed, video cameras must be mounted to the chassis or the bodywork using bolts and secured in place. Cameras can not be attached to the driver or the helmet. In the event of a flip or contact the camera could cause injury.
